

PEC DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

The Professional Engineers in Construction Distinguished Service Award is presented to an engineer practicing in the construction field who has made exceptional contributions to the construction industry.

The purpose of the award is to recognize those individuals who have contributed to promoting the best practices of construction engineering and advancing construction as a discipline of engineering.

Award: The award consists of an engraved plaque.

Qualifications/Method of Selection: The nominee must be a registered professional engineer and a member of MSPE. To be eligible for consideration, nominees must have demonstrated a long-term record of achievements in promoting construction engineering. The award is given to recognize lifetime achievements, rather than outstanding accomplishments for a single event. The recipient is selected by MSPE PEC practice division.

Presentation: The award is presented at the MSPE Annual Convention.
