- Must hold and maintain a valid Certificate of Registration as Professional Engineer (PE) from the Kansas State Board of Technical Professions. If registered in another state, must obtain Kansas registration within one (1) year of hire.
- Must possess a valid driver's license and acceptable driving record per the City's drivers *Use of Vehicles for City Business* policy throughout employment with the City.
